

Chapter 99. Animals

§ 99-5. Running at large; disposal of waste.

[Amended 7-6-2015 by Ord. No. 5-15]

- A. Running at large. No cat, dog or other domesticated animal shall be permitted to run at large within the City of Hudson. An animal is considered to be running at large if it is not on the premises of its owner and is not restrained or under restraint as defined in this chapter.
- B. No dog shall be permitted in a public cemetery, playground, schoolyard, public pool or other posted areas, except when confined within a vehicle or on a leash or except with the written permission of the person in charge.
- C. The owner of an animal shall promptly remove and dispose in a sanitary manner any excreta deposited by such animal upon any public or private property. Seeing-eye dogs used by blind persons or dogs used in police activities are exempted when used by or with the permission of the City.
