



Senior Downtown Parking Permit

Valid from January - December (Renew Annually)

- Available at no cost to seniors who are 65+ years of age
- Available to seniors that live in the City limits of Hudson. (North Hudson, and the County do not qualify)
- Parking permits will allow permit holders to park up to 3 hours on -street parking and 8 hours in certain parking lots listed below.
- All individuals parking permits are for one vehicle license plate only. Limit 1 permit per person.
- If you currently have a handicap placard or plate, you already receive free parking. You will NOT need to fill out a parking permit.

Permit Parking is only Permitted in the Following Locations:

- Beach House Lot (8 Hours) (Located 1st and Vine)
- North Lot (8 Hours) (600 blk of 2nd Street near Wells Fargo)
- Williams Lot (8 Hours) (221 Commerical Street, and Walnut)
- Along 1st Street between Elm Street and Vine Street (8 Hours)
- City Hall Parking Lot, Phipps Parking Lot, North Plaza Lot (3 Hours)
- On Street Parking (3 Hours)

Important Information for Permit Holders

- You will need to renew your parking permit annually. Permit is only valid from January- December
- Once the permit is turned in , it may take up to 2-3 business days for the permit to be entered.
- Permits are available **ONLY** at City Hall (505 3rd Street, Hudson, WI 54016)

****You will NOT receive a physical permit, or a phone call when your parking permit is entered.****
